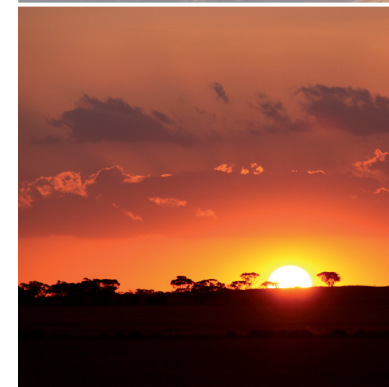

points of interest

- > **Street Murals** illustrating scenes from the town's early years of development.
- > **Bollards** depicting various community sports played in Beulah.
- > **Federation Patchwork Mural** an amazing patchwork quilt housed at the Beulah Business Centre, portraying prominent buildings of the town.
- > **Recreation Reserve** includes football, netball, cricket, tennis, bowls and a public swimming pool.
- > **Vermin Proof Fence** was erected in 1885 along the 36th parallel from the Murray River to the South Australian border with the objective of keeping the rabbits to the south and the dingoes to the north. A small section of fence can be seen on the Henty Highway just south of Beulah at Galaquil.
- > **Yarriambiack Creek** flows to the north from the Wimmera River and ends at Lake Corrong at Hopetoun. Sometimes dry, the Creek channel is narrow and meanders through native trees, agricultural land and bush.
- > **Weir Pool** behind the Recreation Reserve is perfect for recreational boating activities. A walking track surrounds the Weir Pool with outdoor exercise equipment along the way.
