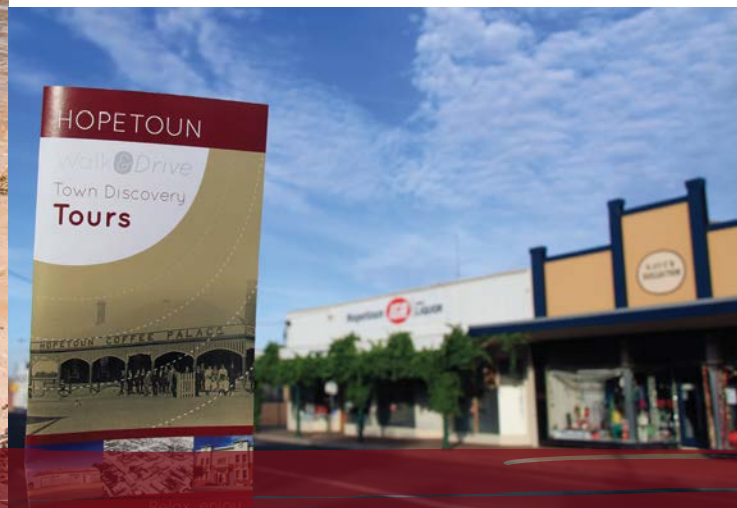

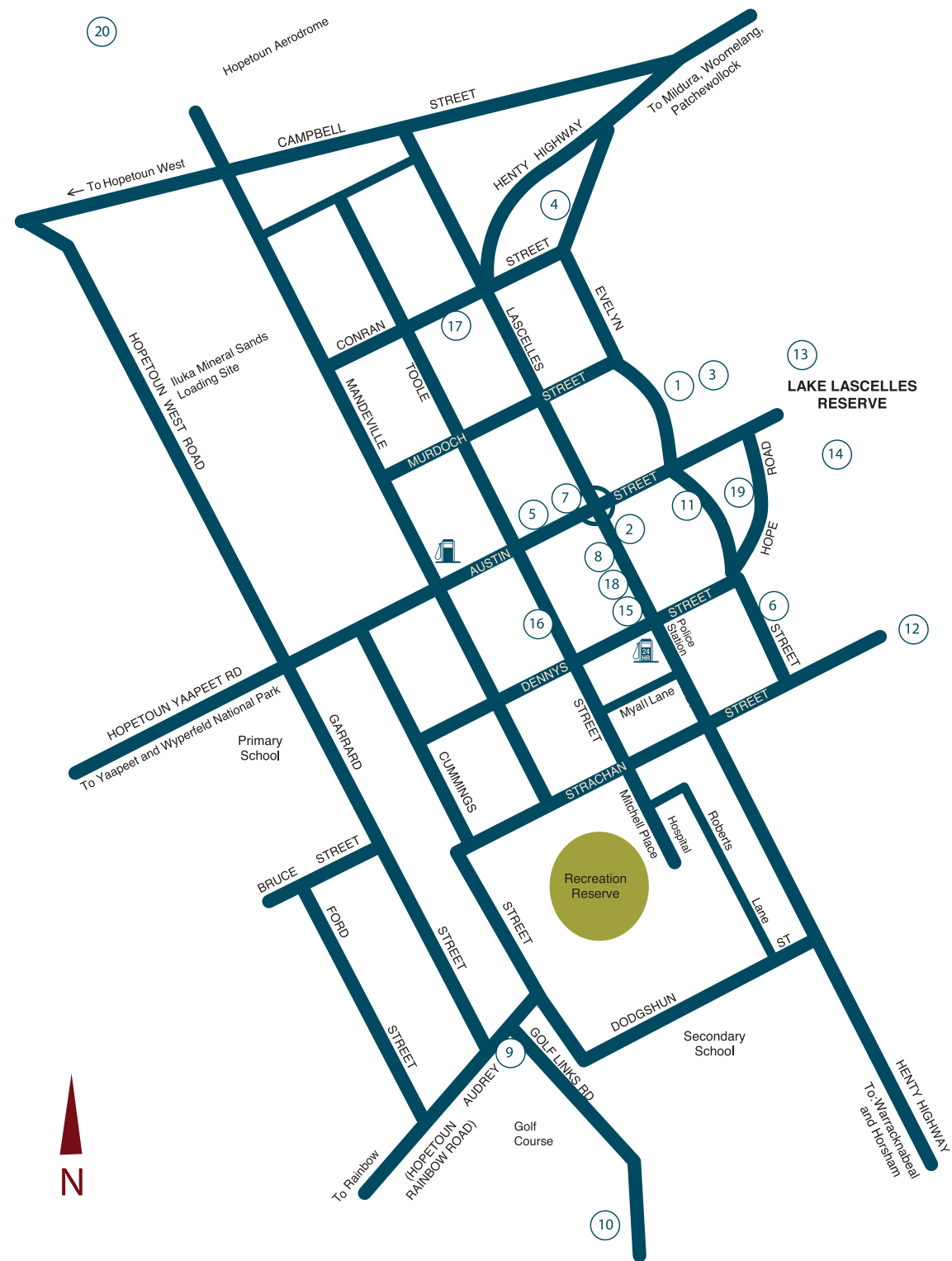

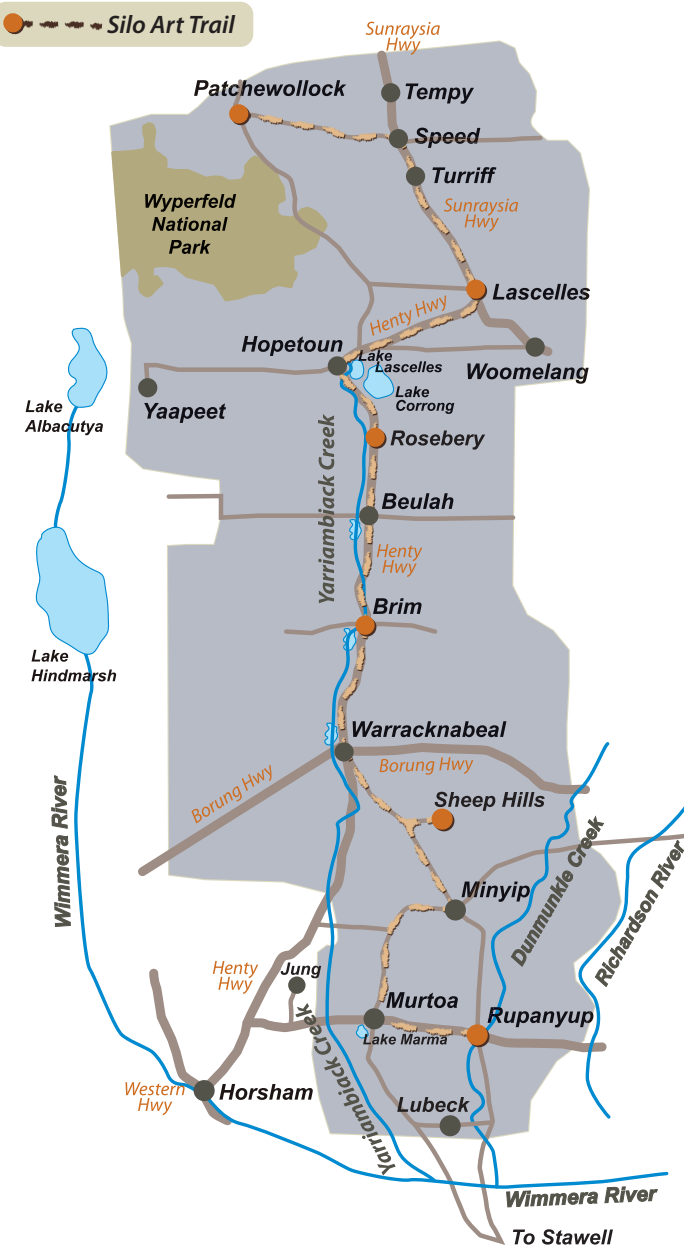

points of interest

- > **Corrong Homestead** was built by the Mallee's first settler Peter McGinnis and is believed to be the oldest original house in the Mallee.
- > **Dr Pete's Park** features a huge mural depicting pioneer heritage and 200 varieties of birds and wildflowers found within the surrounding National Parks and Reserves.
- > **Lake Corrong** is filled by the Yarriambiack Creek and is a haven for a variety birds and a popular fishing hotspot. Lake Corrong is sometimes dry and can be accessed via the Henty Highway, Two Mile Road or the Eastern side of Lake Lascelles.
- > **Lake Lascelles** is walking distance from the town centre and is the perfect location for water sports and fishing. Facilities include BBQ's, shelters, amenities, jetty and boat ramp.
- > **Mallee Bush Retreat** provides a range of accommodation options based on unique designs including 2 Silos, 2 Cow Sheds, Stables, 2 Machinery Sheds, Shearer's Hut and a Limestone Grain Store with 42 beds available. Powered sites are offered at a low cost and free camping is encouraged around the Lake perimeter. T. 0439 529 973 for reservations.
- > **Model Car Raceway** allows visitors to race model cars on a 41 metre, eight lane slot car track. Hire a car and race your friends and family. T. 0429 826 937.
- > **Transfer Station Resale Shed** is open to treasure hunting enthusiasts. Bag a bargain and help reduce landfill.
- > **Silo Art Trail** is Australia's largest outdoor gallery. Hopetoun is a great base for exploring the gigantic artworks in Patchewollock, Lascelles, Rosebery, Brim, Sheep Hills and Rupanyup.
