The original settlement was known as 'Cronomby Tanks', after the natural waterholes that attracted pioneers to settle in the area. According to local folklore the name was changed in 1897 after a passing traveller riding his trusty steed, Melang, and heading for the water source, rode in over the rise and upon seeing the township laid before him, called "Whoa Melang" and from that day forward the township became known as Woomelang.

Woomelang is in close proximity to major natural tourism attractions such as Wyperfeld National Park, Hattah Kulkyne National Park, Pine Plains, Green Lake, Lake Tyrrell and Lake Lascelles.

- > Old Post Office, Historical Society & Op Shop was constructed in 1915 and now houses many historical items and bargains for the savvy shopper.
- > **General Store** provides groceries, banking facilities, takeaway food and post office.
- > **Shearing Shed** constructed from flattened kerosene tins during World War II due to wartime shortages.
- > Cronomby Tanks Recreation Reserve provides free camping and recreation to all. This includes extensive walking tracks, bird watching, fishing and BBQ facilities.
- > CWA Annual Spring Flower Show held annually on the 3rd Thursday in October at the Memorial Hall. Attending the CWA Flower Show is like stepping back in time. The Flower Show exhibits a stunning array of locally grown floral specimens and showcases a variety of local talents incorporating a wide selection of arts and crafts such as cooking, floral arrangement, patchwork, needlework, photography and painting. There's something for everyone, old and young alike. Traditional CWA judging of all entries takes place throughout the morning, with doors open to the public from midday. A BBQ lunch and a hearty afternoon tea of scones and cream, tops off an amazing day out in Woomelang.
